**Softing complies with EU Directive 2011/65 / EU ("RoHS-2") and
Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 of March 31, 2015
("ROHS-3")**

Dear Sir or Madam,

Since 2002, the EU has regulated the "Restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment" under its ROHS Directive. The Directive prohibits the use of lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) above certain thresholds.

In Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 of 31 March 2015, amending the 2011 Directive, the European Commission expanded the list of prohibited substances to include Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), Butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP), Dibutyl phthalate (DBP) and Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP), whose implementation period has expired on July 22, 2019.

Softing has established processes to ensure compliance of products with both Directives mentioned above. Compliance is confirmed at product level via the CE marking of each product and by the CE declaration of conformity.
