Softing complies with EU Directive 2011/65 / EU ("RoHS-2")

Since 2002, the EU has regulated the "Restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment" under its ROHS Directive. The Directive prohibits the use of lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) and polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) above certain thresholds.

Softing's products are compliant with the new version of the Directive (2011/65/EU) to be implemented since January 2013. Compliance with this Directive is confirmed via the CE conformity of each product and is also part of the CE declaration of conformity.

In Directive (EU) 2015/863 of 31 March 2015 amending the 2011 Directive, the European Commission expanded the list of prohibited substances to include bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP), dibutyl phthalate (DBP) and diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP). The new Directive will take effect on July 22, 2019.

Softing is in the process of implementing this change together with its suppliers.
